It is with a sense of respect and appreciation that we honor him in this issue of TRADITION upon his retirement. This gesture is appropriate for two reasons. First, Yummie's commitment to the totality of *Torah yahadut* is profound and his devotion to Torah learning and hashkafic discourse is admirable. TRADITION, the RCA-sponsored journal for discussing the interface of yahadut and contemporary cultural thought, has virtually no peer among intellectual Jewish journals. As Yummie Walfish guided the RCA, including TRADITION, for many years, it is fitting to honor him in our journal.

Yummie and his dear wife, Hindy, are making their future home in Israel. May their aliyah to Israel be a spiritual fulfillment for them as he continues to work on behalf of our tradition with dignity and dedication.

We also wish to thank Rabbis Pesach Z. Levovitz and Joseph S. Ozarowski, Presentation Chairman and Co-Chairman, respectively, of the tribute dinner held in honor of Rabbi Walfish. The tributes presented to Rabbi Walfish at that time are reproduced here.
